



Driver of the Year 2023 POINTS LEAGUE TABLES

National Driver of the Year

Drivers competing at National driving trials:
10 points for 1st place, to 1 point for 10th place.

Drivers competing at Regional driving trials:
6 points for 1st place, to 1 point for 6th place.

Novice Driver of the Year

Drivers competing at novice qualifier events:
6 points for 1st place, to 1 point for 6th place.

Senior Driver of the Year

6 points for 1st place, to 1 point for 6th place
for drivers over 60 years of age, competing at
National and Regional driving trials.

In all Driver of the Year points leagues, the best six results over the season will count.

If an event takes place after the National Championships, points gained will be added to the table for the following year.

A competitor must complete the competition without elimination or retirement to qualify for points and must be resident in the UK or Ireland.

In the event of an equality of points for Champion or Reserve Champion, the better marathon score at the National Championships will decide the winner.

Should only one of the drivers with the tied score compete, they will be deemed to be the winner.

Presentations to the Driver of the Year and the reserve in each class will be made at the National Championships.
